How We are Helping Families

5,200 FAMILIES CALLED OUR HOTLINE.

1,500 FAMILIES RECEIVED DIRECT SERVICES - THAT'S MORE THAN 3,400 PARENTS AND CHILDREN.

675 FAMILIES RECEIVED INTENSIVE CASE MANAGEMENT - INCLUDING CRISIS INTERVENTION AND IMMEDIATE MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELING.

143 FAMILIES WERE PROVIDED EITHER TEMPORARY OR TRANSITIONAL SHELTER.

241 FAMILIES WERE PLACED INTO LONG-TERM HOUSING.

77 FAMILIES RECEIVED RENTAL ASSISTANCE, PREVENTING THEM FROM BECOMING HOMELESS.

210,000 HOURS OF CHILDCARE WERE PROVIDED.

747 FAMILIES RECEIVED DROP-IN GOODS INCLUDING FOOD, HYGIENE ITEMS, DIAPERS AND TRANSPORTATION ASSISTANCE.

3,067 MENTAL HEALTH SESSIONS WERE PROVIDED TO PARENTS AND CHILDREN.

17,781 COUNSELING AND GOAL-SETTING SESSIONS WITH CASE MANAGERS WERE PROVIDED.

98% OF FAMILIES WHO WERE PREVIOUSLY HOUSED REMAINED STABLE UP TO 12 MONTHS FROM EXITING OUR SERVICES.

7,040 INDIVIDUAL AND GROUP VOLUNTEER HOURS WERE COMPLETED.
