



## DRI Financial Aid Policy

Individuals who demonstrate need may receive limited financial aid to attend DRI CLE programs. To qualify, those seeking financial aid must comply with the following terms and conditions:

1. Applicants must be licensed to practice law in the United States, Canada or other foreign jurisdiction. Proof of admission to the bar that includes the applicant's bar or Supreme Court number must accompany the request for financial aid as set forth in the following paragraphs.
2. Applicants must show proof of identity and citizenship.
3. Applicants must execute a written application for financial aid as approved by the DRI Executive Committee. Such application must be delivered to the DRI Education Department, 222 South Riverside Plaza, Suite 1870, Chicago, IL 60606 at least sixty (60) days in advance of the first day of the seminar.
4. Affirmation that the applicant meets the DRI Policy requirements. (Example below.)

5. The failure of the applicant to provide any of the foregoing information in a timely manner will nullify the request for financial aid.
6. DRI will notify financial aid applicants within thirty (30) days of receipt of all required documentation as to whether or not their request for financial assistance is approved or denied.
7. DRI will award financial aid based on the following scale:

Unemployed - Full scholarship  
Income up to \$35,000 - 75% discount  
Income \$35,000 to \$50,000 - 50% discount  
Income above \$50,000 - No discount
