RULES, TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Updated October 1, 2023

1. PROMOTION DESCRIPTION.

The National Foundation for Judicial Excellence (NFJE) supports a strong, independent, responsive judiciary by providing officers of the courts with educational programs and other tools that enable them to perform at their highest level. DRI, Inc. ("DRI") supports NFJE's valuable mission and DRI is conducting this prize sweepstakes ("Promotion") to incentivize DRI members to provide much needed financial support to NFJE. Please legibly enter your name, address, phone-number, and email address, and send your completed entry to DRI/NFJE Promotion, at 222 South Riverside Plaza, Suite 1870, Chicago, IL 60606 no later than October 15, 2023. To participate after October 15, donations should be made through the online process.
- c. IN PERSON. You may enter during the Promotion Period in person at the DRI Annual Meeting on October 25-27, 2023, to be held in San Antonio, Texas. Entry forms will be located at the San Antonio Marriott Rivercenter (101 Bowie Street, San Antonio, TX 78205) at the DRI Hub located on the DRI Annual Meeting Exhibit Showcase floor.

5. PARTICIPATION REWARDS AND PRIZE WINNER SELECTION.

a. DRAWINGS.

Drawings for each of the Prizes in Section 6 will be held on or about October 27, 2023 from all qualified online, mail-in, and in-person entries received. Incomplete entries will not qualify to be entered into the contest. Odds of winning based on the number of tickets submitted by participants. Purchases do not increase the odds of winning.
